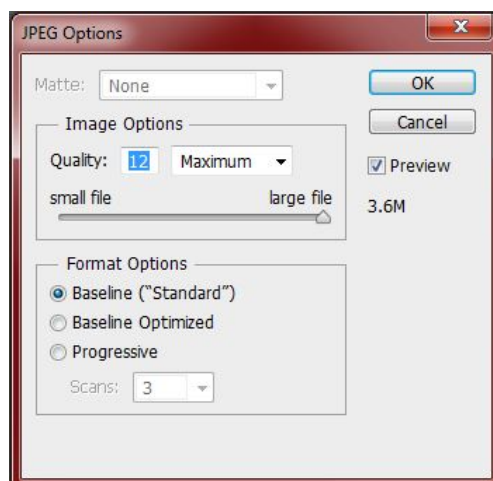
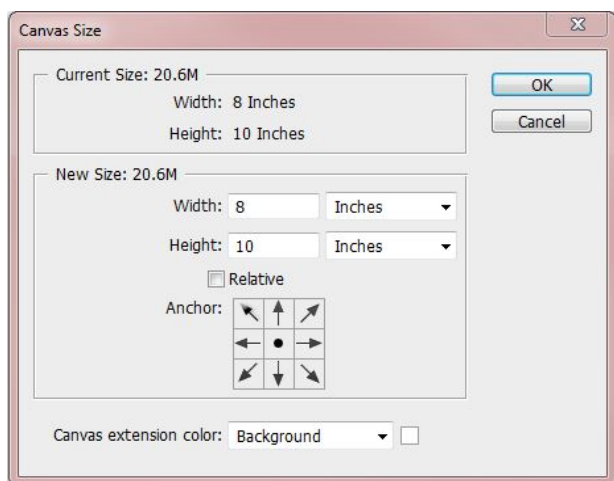


File preparation for printing

Correct file specifications are essential to help us with the processing of your orders properly.

- The most consistent results are achieved having your images in **sRGB**. This is the colour space that best matches our printers' profiles, and it is the most widely used and compatible profile around.
- Save your images as **JPEG** files. Use only the valid file extension of ".jpg or jpeg". Images should be at **300 dpi** at the **correct image dimensions** you require to print.
- Always keep important information such as borders, text, faces at least **5mm** away from the edge of your print. This will help allow for movement as the paper travels through the printer.



- Please note: Stretched Canvases are wrapped around the timber frame, it needs 50mm extra allowance for the wrapping on all sides. Please take this to consideration when preparing your file for Stretched Canvases. Options are - wrap around, white sides or gallery wrapping.

- *For our larger prints we leave excess paper attached when it is available, the prints are not trimmed to size as it makes it easier for framers. If you require your prints trimmed to size you must request this service.*

- When submitting files disc/USB/, please place your images in folders named to reflect your required print size (in inches) and paper type (only if other than lustre) as shown here. If you require multiple prints of the same image, name the folder with size and quantity.
